Air Inlet Duct

Parts

1 ea. Duct mount

2 ea. Clamps

1 ea. Gasket

- 1. Use 7/16" wrench to remove the four nuts holding the heater to the firewall. You do not have to remove the heater hoses.
- 2. Disconnect the original heater air inlet duct from the kick panel by pulling on the plastic strap lock.
- 3. From the inside of the Bronco, pull heater out slightly to give yourself access to reach the seven screws which hold the original duct to the heater.
- 4. Use 5/16" socket to remove the seven screws and remove the old duct and gasket.
- 5. Position the new duct mount and gasket to the heater and use the same seven screws to attach the new duct mount
- 6. Use a 7/16" wrench to bolt the heater back to the firewall.
- 7. Clamp the duct to the kick panel and duct mount using the large hose clamps.
