## **Under Seat Storage Compartment**

### **Parts**

### **Hardware**

Ok so now that you have your very stout passenger side under seat storage compartment you may be wondering how to mount it in your Bronco. That may depend on where you are at with the overall Bronco project. For example if you are in the middle of a complete paint job with everything striped out of the interior then we would recommend that you have it welded in place. Then you can paint or bed liner over the whole thing. If your Bronco interior is super nice already you may want to primer and paint the compartment and then bolt it in place. There are mounting holes in two sections of the compartment which can be used for this method. You could also drill additional holes in other locations if desired. The main thing is to get the compartment into the Bronco as square as possible. You want a nice flat surface basically using the compartment as an extension of the existing floor. The Broncos are usually not perfectly square so some varying gaps may be seen especially at the back. You can use seam sealer if desired to fill in these gaps.
